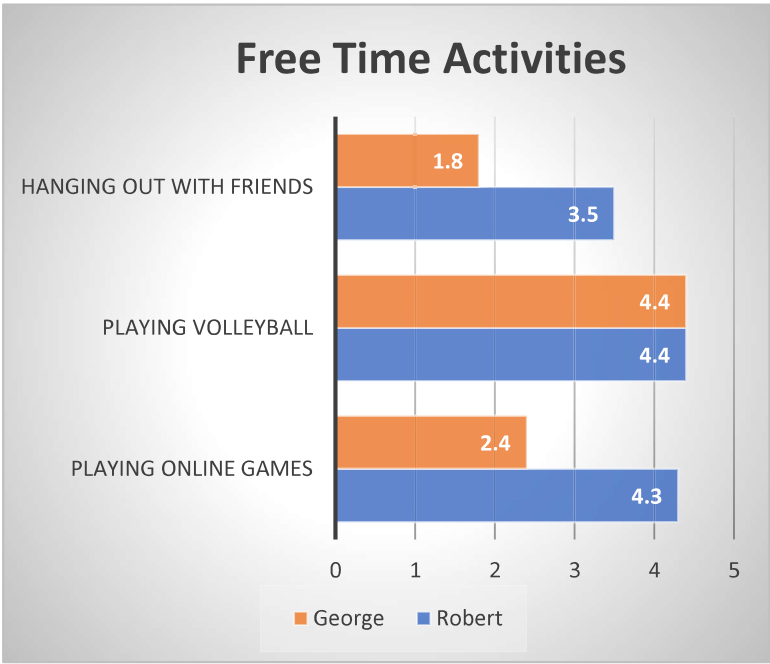

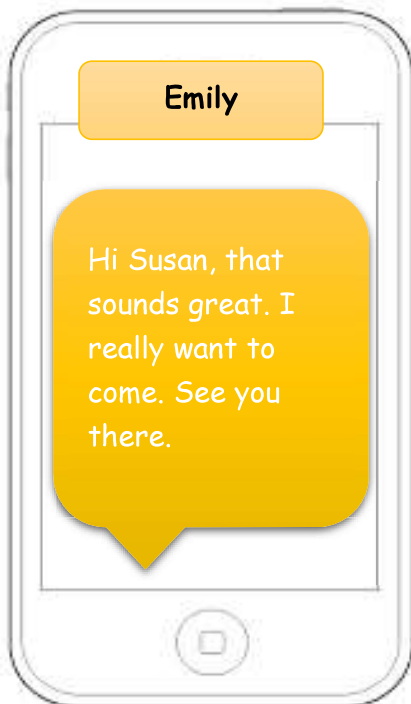
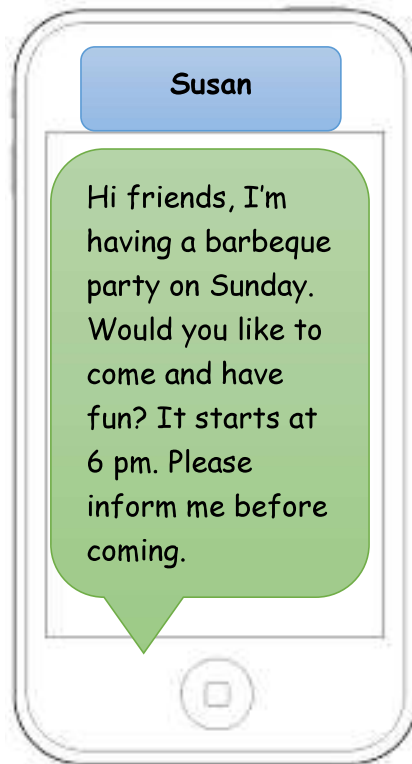


George and Robert are twins. They have similar and different interests. The table above shows how they spend their free time and the activities they like doing.
